First four editions pdf newsletters content, does not have reflow or read out loud functionality, no navigation headers.

Edition five no navigation headers.

The Mayor

Poor contrast on links in body text. – Resolved

Former years pdf content, does not have reflow or read out loud functionality, no navigation headers.

Your Councillors

Councillors image links contain no text.

Duplicated alt text on images.

Next and previous text are small on individual Councillors pages.

Next and previous buttons reporting redundant link as they function the same as adjacent text.

Standing Orders Guidance for Members limited reflow functionality some pages are also off center in the reflowed layout, no navigation headers.

Standing Orders Tendering and Contracts has read out loud functionality and limited reflow functionality, no navigation headers.

Publication Scheme document no navigation headers or reflow functionality.

Land and Property document no navigation headers or reflow functionality.

Revenue Budget no navigation headers.

Job Descriptions (all) no navigation headers and limited reflow functionality.
